In the Table 2 Provisions for Single Exponential Smoothing Forecasting, the table show that for $\alpha = 0.1$, MSE is smallest MSE but not smallest MAPE. Why the authors using $\alpha = 0.1$?

Reviewer #2: The authors not suitable with reference style of journal, the authors must be revised.

- The authors not explain what the purpose of the study.
- The authors only use 3 keyword, Instruction of authors --> Please provide 4 to 6 keywords which can be used for indexing purposes.

The authors not inform:

- Funding (information that explains whether and by whom the research was supported)
- Conflicts of interest/Competing interests (include appropriate disclosures)
- Availability of data and material (data transparency)
- Code availability (software application or custom code)
- Authors' contributions (optional: please review the submission guidelines from the journal whether statements are mandatory)
